The UIA Board of Directors held a board meeting on Monday, April 8, 2024. The meeting was live streamed to allow public viewing. UIA Chair Derek Oyler (Brigham City) called the meeting to order at 8:39 AM. He welcomed all attendees.

- FY 2025 Proposed Executive Budget was presented
- Projected revenue increase of \$8.5 million
- Possible rate increase of \$4 per month on most products due to inflationary pressures and bonding needs
- May be able to free up cash from bond reserve accounts and not have to increase rates
- Last rate increase was over 10 years ago
- Projected operating expense increase of \$7.4 million
- UTOPIA distribution to cities increasing by the amount of city debt payments

ACTION: Dan Johnson (West Valley City) MOVED to approve Resolution 24-01 adopting the UIA Tentative Budget for FY 2025 and setting the time and place for a public hearing (June 10, 2024). Zach Bloxham (Layton City) SECONDED the motion. A roll call vote was taken - vote was unanimous.

Carolyn Lundberg (Lindon City) SECONDED the motion. A roll call vote was taken - vote was unanimous.
