1. WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS

The UIA Board of Directors held a board meeting on Monday, February 10, 2025. The meeting was live streamed to allow public viewing. UIA Chair Derek Oyler (Brigham City) called the meeting to order at 8:46 AM and welcomed all attendees.

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES – DECEMBER 9, 2024

ACTION: Brenda Moore (Murray City) MOVED to approve the minutes from the UIA Board Meeting held December 9, 2024. Carolyn Lundberg (Lindon City) SECONDED the motion. A voice vote was taken - vote was unanimous.

3. ELECTION OF 2025 UIA BOARD OFFICERS

- The following nominations were made: Chair Derek Oyler (Brigham City), 1st Vice Chair Brant Hanson (Centerville City), 2nd Vice Chair Brenda Moore (Murray City) & 3rd Vice Chair Zach Bloxham (Layton City)

ACTION: Brant Hanson (Centerville City) MOVED to approve the 2025 UTOPIA Board Leadership as follows: Chair – Derek Oyler (Brigham City), 1st Vice Chair – Brant Hanson (Centerville City), 2nd Vice Chair – Brenda Moore (Murray City) & 3rd Vice Chair – Zach Bloxham (Layton City). Brenda Moore (Murray City) SECONDED the motion. A roll call vote was taken - vote was unanimous.

4. <u>DISCUSSION OF UIA POLICIES</u>

- Item presented by Mr. Jason Roberts, UIA Secretary/Treasurer
- Ms. Nicole Cottle aided in drafting after reviewing similar policies of several UIA member cities and curating them to function effectively for UIA
- Written policies to increase Fraud Risk Assessment Score:
 - o Reporting Fraud & Abuse Policy
 - Fraud can be reported to multiple people
 - Investigation and resolution procedures
 - Periodic training for employees
 - There is currently a link on the website to the fraud reporting hotline
 - o Cash Receipting & Deposits
 - UIA is significantly different from cities regarding cash, very rare to receive cash payments
 - Credit & Purchasing Card Policy
 - Similar to cities
 - Prohibited: personal purchases, cash advances or withdrawals & alcohol, tobacco, and any other non-business-related items

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- Monthly reconciliation and supervisor approval
- Questions regarding capability to download transactions directly to General Ledger – separate person in system that ensures no changes have been made from what was downloaded
- Applications required for all needing a P-Card Mr. Roberts committed to add that to internal procedures
- Rewards Programs Process –cash back is put back into the funds of UTOPIA and added to the budgeting process, no cardholders have access to the cash back funds
- Statement of Ethical Behavior will be sent to all board members and employees to sign which will increase fraud risk assessment score
 - Add that State Auditor training has been completed

ACTION: Brenn Bybee (Orem City) MOVED to approve the UIA policies presented – Reporting Fraud & Abuse, Cash Receipting & Deposits and Credit & Purchasing Card Policy. Zach Bloxham (Layton City) SECONDED the motion. A voice vote was taken - vote was unanimous.

5. UIA FINANCIAL AUDIT FY2024

- Financial Highlights:
 - o Average monthly recurring revenue increased by 18.3%
 - o Number of subscribers on UIA/UTOPIA network increased by 13.1%
 - o Operating Revenue increased by 18.2%
 - o Added \$67.2 million to fixed assets
 - o Cash Reserves adequate to cover 0.9 years of operating expense less depreciation
- Financials of UIA were audited to obtain reasonable assurance, clean opinion
- No issues with UIA internal controls or State Compliance
- UIA has reliable accounting systems and sound accounting policies

- Projected budget vs. adopted budget as of December 31, 2024
 - o Difference in projections vs. budgeted is mostly due to timing in the year
- Financial charts
 - o 10 Year Monthly Recurring Revenue (Combined UIA & UTOPIA)
 - UIA Revenue v. Bond Obligation
 - Gap between bond payments and revenue continues to widen

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7. <u>UIA NETWORK UPDATE</u>

- Reviewed subscriber report
 - o Generally, things are slow in January and February
 - Correction made to how addresses are reported which caused an increase in take rate
- Legislative Impact a few bills may affect UIA, but he believes they will not have a large negative impact
- Mr. Jeff Erwin, UTOPIA Chief Operations Officer, provided a network usage report and was pleased to share there were no issues during the large usage event from the Superbowl
- Door to Door Sales going well in West Valley City. Mr. Erwin provided data related to the effectiveness of the effort.
